In the early spring of 2010 my wife and I decided we would look into the installation of a solar electric system on the roof of our house. We consulted with three or four providers. In the end we selected Enviro-Energy Technologies Inc. Our decision was based upon two main criteria, the product and our judgment of Steve Eng, an energy engineer with the company.

There are many products on the market. Mr. Eng provided us with information on appropriate products and costs. The cost of installation seems to vary widely. We settled on a 5 kW system. We were impressed with his engineering expertise which we felt would be an asset for our project of joining the Ontario Government FIT program.

Once we had committed ourselves, we were confronted with details related to installation and the complex agreements and permits that had to be finalized. It is in this area that Mr. Eng was a reliable and conscientious guide. Over a period of weeks, he walked us through the whole process and, especially with regards to permits and agreements, he handled many of the details on our behalf. For us it became a stress-free process. During the installation, Mr. Eng was on site at all times directing his crew while consulting with the electricians and the representatives from Ontario Hydro who were also present. As a professional engineer, Mr. Eng is very particular about getting all the details right. Our system went into operation in early September and we have had no problems of any kind.

Should we undertake other installations or an upgrade to our system, we would contact Mr. Eng without hesitation. We look forward to sharing details on the performance of our rooftop power station with Mr. Eng during the coming the year.
